Greetings to all our brothers and sisters world-wide.

We have experienced an active month, with many people travelling to various places. Otto, Tineke and Ronny left for Australia to visit a few assemblies there. Four people travelled to England to attend their Spring Camp, while quite a number headed east to Hungary for the camp there. The theme was 'Truth with Proof'. To top it off, a few more travelled to Hungary at the end of the month to lend support to their 1st of May Open-Air concert-outreach.

Four people were baptised by full immersion this month in Dordrecht, receiving the Holy Spirit, speaking in tongues.

Neh 8:10 'for the joy of the Lord is your strength." This scripture was mentioned in a talk this month reminding us that we can have great joy just by knowing that we are children of God. What we have is not normal but FANTASTIC and we can have happiness and peace by following the simple gospel that has been preached to us. Now is the time to be serious, enthusiastic and to encourage one another knowing we have the power and have been made capable to overcome everything. Remain faithful and walk in thankfulness.

Gleaned from talks at the Hungarian Camp:

- ? God made the environment and placed man in it to perform. We also try to create an environment to invite people into to perform.
- ? No Holy Spirit, no truth and no understanding of the truth.
- ? Dan 3 and Dan 6 tells us that we never need to compromise in any way.
- ? An uncompromising approach pays off in a big way.
- ? We are called to wait, which means to EXPECT.
- ? All the ingredients are there, and mixed in the right way, will give beautiful results.

- ? The story in 1Kings 18: Our God is not like their gods. Result 185,000 dead enemies.
- ? Mark 1:16-17. An unknown man comes up to you and says: "Follow me" and they do, astonishing!
- ? When God does a miracle people explain it away as coincidence. When a disaster happens the same people often deny a possible coincidence and blame God for it.
- ? Eph 1:5. We are predestined to be adopted as children. It is up to us to avail ourselves for this and to stay that way.

- ? Heb 3:8. "harden not your hearts" People who harden their hearts cannot see anything positive. The people of Israel had a whopping big fire column in front of them every day and they probably said: "you see any miracles around here? I don't."
- ? John 14:8. Philip said: "show us the father" Jesus said: "can't you see Him in me?" If you can't, look at the miracles (vers 11) In the same way people should be able to see the Father also in us!
- ? KNOWING the truth, what are we going to DO with it?
- ? What makes the truth the truth?
- ? 1Ki 18, Elijah knew it was going to work, no risk at all because it was the truth.
- ? John 18: 37. Jesus: "to this end was I born." To be a witness of the truth!
- Per Heb 11, the chapter of the hero's of faith from the old testament. Abraham and Sarah are mentioned but when we read Gen 17:17 and 18:12 we see that they laughed at God's

- promise, still they are mentioned as faithful people. God is greater than our human doubts.
- ? We have been given enough information to survive anything.
- ? It does not matter what we **plan** to do, it matters what we actually do.
- ? Truth with proof does not only apply to our "little" healings and provisions, it applies to the whole of creation, including all mankind. Everybody proves the Bible to be true in everything they say, do, or not do.
- ? Even bad or disobedient people fulfil prophesy.
- ? We don't distort things to make them fit into preconceived ideas.
- ? All solutions to our personal problems are to be found in a "back to basics" approach, not in a "let's look for extra's" approach.

Holland

Concert

Last Davs

We had a very interesting presentation from Ps. Piet which looked into the Biblical history of mankind. Short Talks

- ? Frans spoke about if you are doubtful in your faith, your walk will not only take a downward spiral, but it will be evident to those around you that you lack confidence—especially those in the world you have been called to save. If you do everything wholeheartedly with boldness, you will overcome, see results and your walk will take an upwards spiral.
- ? Arnos' talk was titled 'Keep Walking.' To start our walk we must be born-again (there is no other way). Our motivation to keep walking is the love of God and the love of the truth. We must do what God asks of us. Why do we keep walking? Because it is the best thing we can do and our reward is eternal life. Arno ended his talk with this quote; "When was the last time you did something for the first time?"
- ? Arend spoke about singing. We can often read accounts in the Bible of people who sang praises to God, demonstrating an overcoming mentality and thankfulness to God. People were demonstrating faith, knowing God had given the victory. We must not be influenced by the negativity of the world but know that God is working in our life plenty of reason for us to lift our voices in praise.
