Holland

Presentation: The Last Days

To examine ourselves if we really are in the faith or not, 2Cor13:5. We shouldn't deceive ourselves by saying that everything is o.k. When we really know through the Holy Spirit that it isn't. So if cracks are forming in your life, sort them out today. "Fixing a hole in your roof in the sunshine instead of in the rain is much better". So do what needs to be done today because you don't know what is ahead.
- ? Brother Paul spoke about the "Simpleness of the gospel". How that it is one of our greatest assets. He said that we should never forget how

simple it was for us when we heard the gospel and that nothing has changed with the gospel its only us who change so lets get back the simplicity of God's Word.

? Pastor Piet spoke about "effective fasting". What is effective fasting, fasting that brings results. In Isaiah 59:2 it is written "your iniquities have separated between you and your God". What are iniquities: not straight/right but crooked. Everything that isn't right or crooked separates us from God. So if we are praying about something for a while or even years then we need to change to get a result. Quoted "Insanity: doing the same thing over and over again expecting one day a different result". If you want a result then you must change. Believe, do good and results will be there.

We had a relaxing night with a film for the children and fellowship afterwards. It was a needed breather after such a very busy last three months.

TESTIMONY

I was born in 1979 and both my parents were married, spirit filled and in the Revival Fellowship. My mum is from Melbourne, and was bought up a Methodist.
