# **Outreach**

## Speaking in Tongues

1. It is the sign of receiving the Holy Spirit; And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. Acts 2:4.

2. By praying in tongues, or in the Spirit, we build up our faith; **But ye, beloved, building up yourselves** on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost. Jude 20.

3. In the church it is a sign for the unbeliever when used in the spiritual gifts; Wherefore tongues are for a sign, not to them that believe, but to them that believe not. 1Cor 14.

Speaking in tongues has not ceased as some believe and is not a optional extra; Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. Rom 8:9.

## Kids Camp

It was that time of the year again when our children, aged 7-12, held their camp. They all look forward to this with much excitement! This year it was held at a perfect location set in the midst of a forest. There were 14 children and 7 leaders (all feeling their age afterwards). Johan spoke about trusting the Lord with all your heart, Prov3:5. We worship a God (the only God) that provides answers. He gives us the victory in every situation and we need not fear what the world puts in our path as He does not leave us. We have to trust in Him and when we do, we can overcome the world.

Ben spoke about relationships. The centre of a good team is the Lord and the priority of a good relationship is to place the Lord as number one in your lives. The Lord knows your desires and what you need in your life so there is no need to strive after these things.

Pastor Piet spoke about what gives real joy. We came to the Lord because we did not find it in the world – so there is no point in going back there to look for it. It isn't there! The world places pressure on us to conform, but work, career, possessions etc. have nothing to do with the Lord. We received Gods love through the Holy Spirit and a hope that does not disappoint. Three years ago I was working in a shop in Australia. It was there that I first heard the gospel from a colleague.
